ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Anyone who regularly conducts business with the Caswell County Clerk of Superior Court's Office, Caswell County Tax Department or the Caswell County Register of Deeds' Office who is not otherwise exempt from the courthouse ban on electronic devices may request permission to bring an electronic device into the courthouse. The request is to be submitted to the Sheriff of Caswell County in writing and on letterhead if possible. The request shall state the person's business as well as why they need to be able to bring the device in to conduct their business. The Sheriff will submit the request to the Clerk of Superior Court of Caswell County and/or the Chief District Court Judge for Judicial District 17A. The request will be approved or denied by the Clerk of Superior Court and/or the Chief District Court Judge upon vetting of the Sheriff. Approvals will be in writing and signed by the Clerk of Superior Court and/or the Chief District Court Judge. The Clerk of Superior Court and/or the Chief District Court Judge may revoke permission without advance notice or hearing. They will be good for one year from the date of signing unless revoked prior to that date. A copy of the signed approval shall be provided to the Sheriff and his personnel conducting security at the public entrance to the courthouse.

This Administrative Order shall become effective upon filing and shall remain in full force and effect until modified as by law allowed.
